



CitiPower and Powercor to use dorsaVi's wearable sensor technology in manual handling injury prevention program for staff

The program will include the use of an onsite resource to assess the movement profile of staff and provide a tailored exercise program using dorsaVi's ViMove2 technology. dorsaVi's ViSafe will be used to identify and prioritise movement risks at a task and job role level, and myViSafe (small sensor and app-based technology) will be used by the business to drive behavioural change in performing manual handling activities. The overall aim of the program will be to reduce manual handling injury risk and improve health and wellbeing.

CitiPower and Powercor's Head of Health, Safety and Environment, Steve Bourke, said "safety was the business' number one value and we look forward to partnering with dorsaVi to improve our safety performance".

dorsaVi Chief Executive Officer Andrew Ronchi noted: "We are pleased to add CitiPower and Powercor as a client among our work with other infrastructure companies.
