Two NBA playoff contenders in the United States adopt ViPerform

Melbourne, Australia and Oakland, CA – Medical device company dorsaVi Ltd (ASX: DVL) has today announced the signing of its first two National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, the Golden State Warriors and the Houston Rockets.

Incorporating advanced technology to measure and monitor player movement and assess risk of injury is increasingly seen as key considerations by professional teams to optimise athletic performance.

The Warriors and Rockets played each other for Western Conference Finals this week in the NBA Playoffs. Both teams have been working closely with dorsaVi to monitor and assess players' movement, risk of injury and return to play. By collaborating closely with elite sports teams around the globe, dorsaVi has gained great insights that have been utilised in continued product innovation applicable to both the OHS and clinical markets for assessing and guiding the treatment of casual sports enthusiasts as well as injured workers.

dorsaVi USA President, John Kowalczyk, said: "We have an expanding portfolio of professional sports clubs using ViPerform to inform injury recovery programs and develop changes to training regimes to avoid fatigue and assess injury."

"The Warriors and Rockets have demonstrated creativity and progressive approaches across their franchise. Their willingness to invest in and advance the use of technology with the goal of increasing performance, assessing the risk of player injury and supporting a quick return to play following injury is a testament to their commitment to excellence."

ViPerform is designed to measure biomechanics and provide immediate biofeedback for technique improvement on or off the court. The device consists of small wearable sensors that are placed on the body and provide immediate analysis of movement and muscle activity by recording objective data and delivering this through the software as a concise meaningful report.

ViPerform can maximise athlete performance through individualised study of movement and various metrics that might affect performance, including range of motion, acceleration and force exerted.
